Right to Work and Earn a Living Legal Challenge

The Irish Council for Human Rights (“ICHR”) is accepting applications from business owners who have been negatively impacted by the Covid-19 laws, for a Right to Work legal challenge.

The proposed legal case will not be limited to any one type of business or any one plaintiff as the ICHR hope to run a test case using a restaurant, while also recruiting twenty or so other plaintiffs across a range of businesses (including but not limited to gyms, bookstores, coffee shops, barbers, salons, gift shops, clothes shops). The purpose of running this action as a test case is to establish a precedent which will be followed in the other cases.
